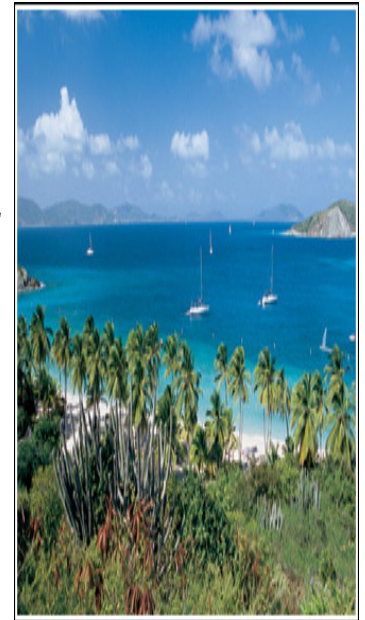
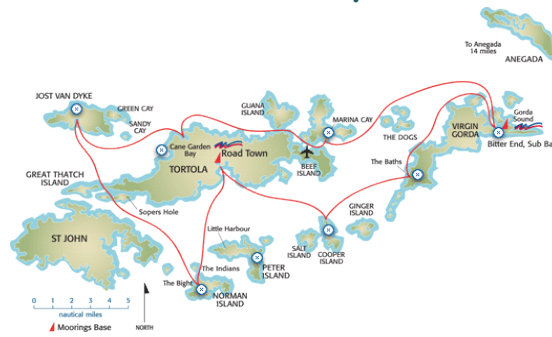


# MARINA SAILING BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS FLOTILLA JUNE 1-10, 2012



Cruise with other club members as we explore the British Virgin Islands on cruising catamarans. Enjoy beautiful breezes, flat protected waters, excellent snorkeling, fun restaurants on the beach, dining on the beach, swimming in caves, climbing on boulders into amazing pools and best of all enjoy swimming in 85 degree water!



**Friday, JUNE 1:** Depart on American Airlines flight 238 from LAX to SJU (San Juan PR) at 11:45pm, arriving in San Juan on June 2 at 11:50am.

**Saturday, JUNE 2:** Transfer to AA flight 4821, departing at 11:50am, arriving in Beef Island, Tortola (EIS) at 12:31pm. Take the shuttle to the charter base, relax by the pool and do the chart briefing at 4pm. We'll provision the boats this afternoon, get checked out on the boats, then settle in on the boat at 6pm, and have dinner at the open air restaurant by the pool.

**Sunday, JUNE 3:** Set sail this morning for Norman Island. We'll pick up a mooring at the "Caves" for awesome snorkeling and exploring, then overnight at "The Bight". We'll enjoy dinner and dancing tonight on the Pirate Ship, "Willy T's", or on the beach at Pirates Bight.

**Monday, JUNE 4:** This morning we sail over to the Indians, pick up a mooring and enjoy excellent snorkeling. We continue on to Peter Island and anchor at the most beautiful beach in the Virgin Islands, Dead Man's Bay. Take the dinghy ashore then relax and explore on this lovely beach. This afternoon we pick up a mooring at Marina Cay and have dinner at Pusser's on the Beach. Excellent snorkeling here.

**Tuesday, JUNE 5:** We set sail to weather this morning for "The Baths" on Virgin Gorda". We'll pick up a mooring, and then enjoy fabulous snorkeling and exploring in and around the huge boulder caverns. After lunch we sail to the Bitter End on Virgin Gorda. We will anchor at Saba Rock, and then have dinner ashore at the "Pub"

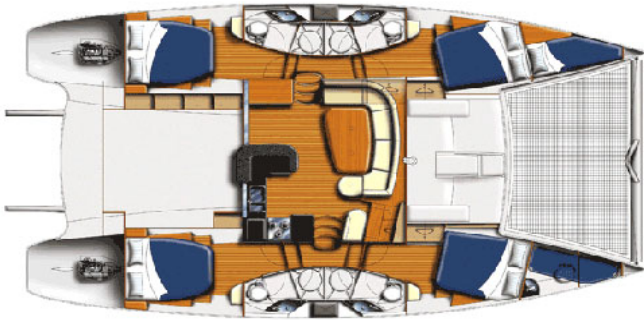
**Wednesday, JUNE 6:** Spend the day enjoying the North Sound Resorts and enjoy the activities. This is a great place to rent some small dinghies and have a sailing regatta. Also, good diving nearby. Explore the Bitter End Resort and take the nature trail to exclusive Biras Creek. Walk to their amazing beach and check out the reception area high up on the hill overlooking the Atlantic and Caribbean seas. Best Pina Colodas on the islands here at the reception bar..

**Thursday, JUNE 7:** We go on a "Real Sail" today to Jost Van Dyke. Pick up a mooring at White Bay. Enjoy the famous "Painkiller" at the Soggy Dollar Bar. Take your camera and enjoy the best fun beach anywhere in the Caribbean. Snorkel on the reef and dinner on board tonight.

**Friday, JUNE 8:** Sail over to Sandy Cay in the morning. This Cay is the most photographed in the Caribbean. Enjoy a pleasant hike around the Cay, then sail down to Cane Garden Bay. This is a huge bay with lots of restaurants on the beach. The bay is a perfect place to practice your stand up paddle boarding. On shore there is an old Rum Distillery. Tonight we can have a party on the beach then have dinner ashore at one of the fun restaurants.

**Saturday, JUNE 9:** This morning, sail down to West End, Sopers Hole, and pick up a mooring and check out the fun shops and enjoy a Painkiller at Pusser's Restaurant. Then we head over to the best snorkeling in the islands at the Indians. Pick up a mooring, have lunch on the boat, then snorkel around the pinnacles. Turtles can often be spotted here. Sail back to the Charter base and dock. We'll take a final dip in the pool, then dinghy over for dinner tonight..

**Sunday June 10:** Depart on AA# 4821, departing EIS at 8:20am, arrive in San Juan at 9:03am, then transfer to AA#239, nonstop to Los Angeles, arriving at 3:15pm. Current Airfare on aa.com= \$1022 per person.



**COSTS and INFO:** For eight nights aboard the 46' Catamaran (with air conditioning) with four cabins and four heads, total boat fee is \$1295 per person.
