We'll sail aboard luxury catamarans and enjoy fabulous sailing and the best destinations. Join us!



Sunday, April 29 Fly from LAX aboard American Airlines flight 280 to Miami and on to St. Maarten aboard flight 729, arriving at 8:30pm. Take the shuttle to Captain Olivers Resort in Oyster Pond, have a light dinner at Captain Olivers Resort, then overnight on board.



Monday, April 30 Provision the boat and attend chart briefing and checkout, then set sail for Orient Bay. We'll anchor off the small island and enjoy the white sandy beach with all the fun activities on shore. Dinner on the beach tonight in one of the open air restaurants.

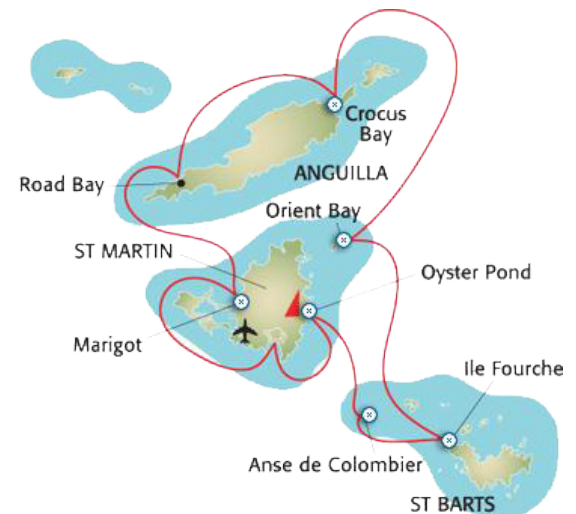


Tuesday, May 1 Sail south to St Barts island, stopping along the way at the island of Ile Fourche for lunch and exploring, then on to picture-perfect Anse de Colombier at the very tip of the island. Steep hills overlook the blue waters of the bay. A village is situated nearby and is well worth the hike, in part because on the way you'll see stunning views of the surrounding islands. Barbeque on board tonight.



Wednesday, May 2 Cruise down to Gustavia. Pick up a mooring near "Les Saintes" for superb snorkeling. This is the place to go ashore, take a taxi or rent a moped to see this amazing island with all its white sand beaches, fun shopping and excellent restaurants. Tonight we will have dinner ashore at Cheeseburgers in Paradise.

Thursday, May 3 A downwind sail to the north-west puts you in Great Bay on Dutch St. Maarten in a couple hours at most. Philipsburg, the Dutch capital, is a thriving waterfront port with lively nightlife, many interesting shops, excellent restaurants, and bustling casinos. There's a beach boardwalk lined with restaurants, well worth a stroll before deciding where to eat dinner.





Friday, May 4 Grand Case Bay is a pleasant anchorage for the night, it's known for its wide selection of good restaurants and lively bars (dinghy dockage is available). It's also home to Creole Rock, where the snorkeling is superb.

Saturday, May 5 Leaving St. Martin in your wake, your course will take you westward to the south end of Anguilla, a low island renowned for its scuba diving, restaurants, and laid-back Caribbean charm. Road Bay is an excellent anchorage, one of the most pleasant in the northern Leeward Islands.

It's also the port of entry for cruising yachts and a great place to go ashore for dinner. Not far away is Sandy Island, one of many off-lying areas in Anguilla protected as a marine reserve and a good choice for an afternoon spent swimming or snorkeling.



Sunday, May 6 We'll leave early for a trip out to Prickly Pear Cays for snorkeling and exploring, then continue back to St Martin, sailing around the north end to Tintamarre Island. Bring your camera and enjoy the scenery and white sand beach. We'll eat lunch here, then continue back to Oyster Pond and overnight at the dock. We'll relax by Captain Oliver's bar and the see through pool this afternoon, then a group dinner tonight at Captain Oliver's.

Monday, May 7 Take the shuttle to the airport and catch American Airlines flight 748 at 8am to Miami and connect with flight 203 to Los Angeles, arriving at 4:25 pm.
